HOW INFLATION IS AFFECTING CARDIGAN.





The recent inflation had a massive impact on the everyday lives of millions. Cardigan was not an exception. Essential resources such as food, wages, electricity, oil, gas, and propane became more expensive, playing a significant role in Cardigan's everyday operations.

At an all-time high, inflation averaged around 9.1 percent this year. Food alone has risen 8% this year alone. That translates to an 80,000 dollar increase for Cardigan's dining services budget this year. Oil also plays a significant role in Cardigans day to day operations, since oil provides heating for all of the dorms in the winter. It is shown that Cardigan's oil bill this year has increased

close to 100,000 dollars alone. Inflation is also negatively affecting the stock market as this school's endowment is diversified carefully into the stock market. Cardigan's endowment hit an all time high of 41 million dollars in 2022, and since then it lost 3 million dollars in value. For a safely diversified investment, that is a significant and unexpected swing in value. Transportation is also a big part of Cardigan operations. The AVs that take us to and from games consume fuel, however the oil prices have risen about 60% this year which means it is now 60% percent more expensive to take us to and from games. These are just a few of the operations getting affected because of inflation but is essential to understand the negative effects inflation has had on Cardigan.

VARSITY SOCCER OFF TO A FRESH START

For the first two weeks of the season, the Cougars have been busy doing sports tryouts and practices. Cardigan's varsity soccer team played two games and participated in Williston Northampton's jamboree. In their first game at St. Paul's against Fay School's varsity soccer, the Cougars emerged victorious despite having three days of tryouts and practices. Cardigan's first season game resulted in a 4-2 win. Alex Calabro scored two goals; Carlos Mayer and Tymofii Panasenko each scored a goal as well.

Before the Cougar's game against Austin Prep, the varsity soccer team was finalized with the captain voting. Dohyun (DK) Kim and Tucker Harris were voted co-captains for this year's varsity soccer team. The Cougars traveled south for a game against Austin Prep's JV soccer team. Alex Calabro and Amanuel Levine scored a goal each in the first half, giving the Cougars a two-goal lead.
