



Adoption of Pass/Incomplete Grading Scale

In an effort to relieve the stress of the challenges that distance learning poses, Cardigan will adopt a pass/incomplete system for the final trimester.

Definitions

Pass: the boy has shown engagement with course material, demonstrated understanding of specific learning goals, and grown during the period of distance learning. A student will “pass” the spring term if he meets the standards of the course.

Incomplete: the boy has demonstrated insufficient engagement with distance learning and will be required to follow our existing guidelines for making up incomplete work during the summer. If a boy is struggling or has significant absences from class school that have not been communicated to the school, he will be assigned an “incomplete” and will be provided support, time, and opportunities to fulfill requirements. Year-end grades will be calculated based on an average of the fall and winter terms.
