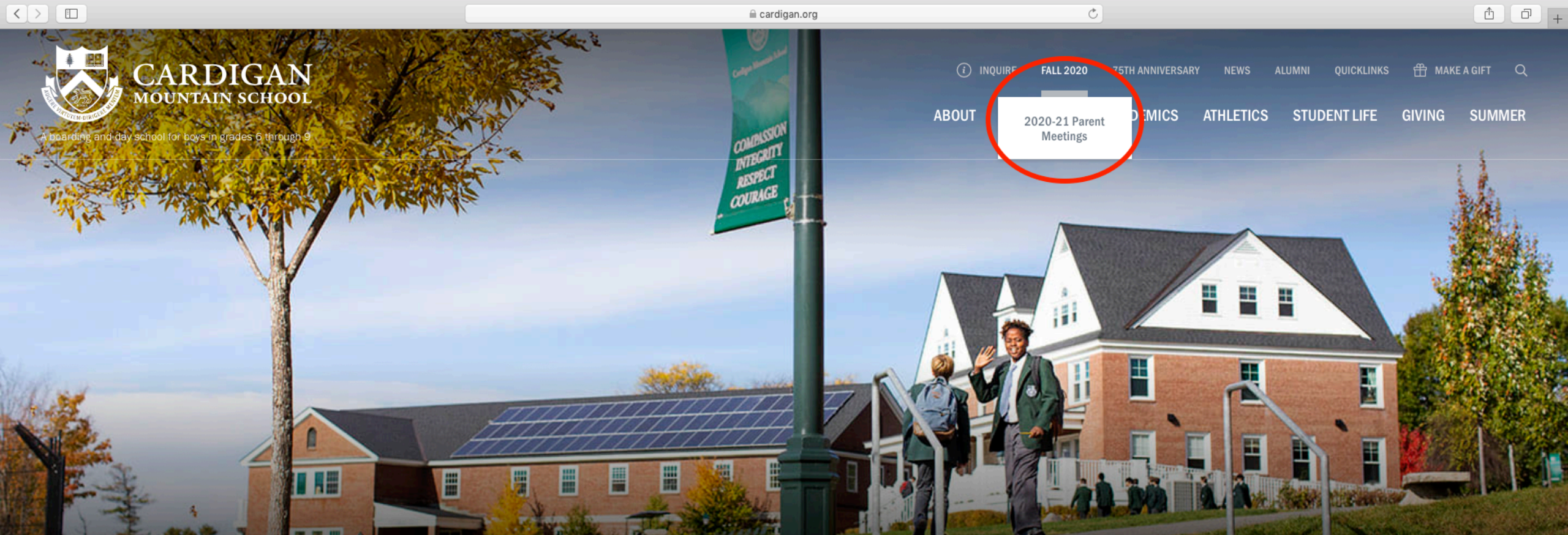

Campus Arrival Procedure

- Prior to Arrival:
 - Self quarantine for 14 days
 - Arrive with 1 family member (max 2) - CMS can pick up students traveling alone
 - Limit the amount of belongings you bring
 - Help your son prepare for his time away from home in the fall
- Registration Days:
 - 8/21 – All day students (quarantine at home, on-campus start date is testing dependent)
 - 8/24 - 9th grade boarding students
 - 8/25 - 8th grade boarding students (Group 1)
 - 8/26 - 8th grade boarding students (Group 2)
 - 8/27 - 6th and 7th grade boarding students

Campus Arrival Procedure

- Gather registration information prior to arrival
- CMS will pick up students at the airport as necessary
- Required testing for students at Mascoma Community Health Center upon arrival
 - 8 students per hour, 8:00AM-6:00PM (8:00AM-12:00PM for Day Students on the 21st)
 - If a student arrives with concerning symptoms, he will need to return home or go straight to on-campus care if home is not an option
 - We will collect student laptops during this process to prepare them for the year
 - Mascoma Community Health Center is located at 18 Roberts Road in Canaan, NH, at the intersection with Route 4.

Registration and Moving In

- Registration process is testing dependent
 - Rapid test results → Open-air registration on the quad
 - No rapid results → Go from Mascoma to your dorm
- Everyone must wear a mask on campus and practice social distancing
- Follow the directions of staff so that we can ensure community safety
- We ask that families not rearrange dorm furniture, including beds, when moving in

Opening Days

- Begin to focus on building safe spaces — families — in the dorms for our students
- We will educate the boys on ways to stay healthy while also fostering culture and community
- We will have a community read (*Stamped*) to involve our entire school in our diversity, equity, and inclusion work
- We are thrilled to have the boys back on campus, and we look forward to living the *Cardigan Way* with them
